At Risk of Financial Instability

Having a disability has a substantial impact on financial status – more than many other variables.





Hardship's Disproportionate Impact

AMONG PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

29% of residents with Two or More

Races





52% of White residents



...were living in financially insecure households





Home Sweet Home?

AMONG PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

96% who own a home & 95% who rent are cost burdened

Cost Burdened, spending at least 35% of their income on their housing





The Challenges of Employment

Jobs are often out of reach for people with disabilities, but even if working full time...

37% of workers with disabilities were still below the ALICE Threshold prepandemic.
